### The Students' Union

The Kokrajhar Law College has the general student Union by name 'Kokrajhar Law College Students' Union' (KLCSU) formed every year as per the guidelines of the Lyngdoh Committee. The membership to the union is compulsory for all students admitted in the college. The Union members are eligible to be the office bearers of Kokrajhar Law College Students' Union either through election or selection from the regular students who are pursuing LL.B. course. The Students' Union is maintained to inculcate the ability of social responsibility and acquire the leadership quality from the student life thereby promoting the integrity amongst the students. The Union conducts different activities from sports to social and legal awareness programs. The Legal Aid Cell of the College is also taken care to facilitate the visitors for legal counseling and advice in the college.

### Special career opportunity:

A free coaching for preparations for competitive is provided to students for appearing in different competitive exams viz ACS, AJS and others. As the law subject has vast career scope.

### **Rules and Regulations**

### Admission Procedure in 3 years LL.B. Course

The Bar Council of India Legal Education Rules 2011 No. 5: (a) Three Year Law Degree Course: An applicant who has graduated in any discipline of knowledge from a University established by an Act of Parliament or by a State legislature or an equivalent national institution recognized as a Deemed to be University or foreign University recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence, may apply for a three years' degree program in law leading to conferment of LL.B. degree on successful completion of the regular program conducted

by a University whose degree in law is recognized by the Bar Council of India for the purpose of enrolment.

The Bodoland University Regulation and Syllabus and Eligibility for Admission:

**3yr. Law Degree Course**: An applicant who has graduated in any discipline of Knowledge from a university established by an Act of Parliament or by a state legislature or from an equivalent national institution recognized as a deemed to be University or from a foreign university recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence, may apply for a three year law degree course leading to conferment of LL.B. degree on successful completion of the regular course.

Provided that applicants who have obtained First Degree Certificate after pursuing studies in distance or correspondence method shall also be considered eligible for admission in the 3yr. law degree course.

An application for admission for the LL.B. course will be done through the SAMARTH portal of Bodoland University under the supervision of the office of the Principal, Kokrajhar Law College as per the public notification. The online applications for the admission is processed through the Admission Committee as per the relevant rules by the Bar Council through notifications, circulars etc. and with provisions of the Bodoland University guidelines for admission. The selected candidates list for the admission at Kokrajhar Law College will be displayed in the website <a href="www.klc.ac.in">www.klc.ac.in</a> and also in college notice board.

### **Eligibility:**

The applicant must be Graduate in Three years Degree Course from any discipline eg; BA, B.SC, B.COM, B.TECH, etc. securing a minimum pass percentage of 45% marks for General category candidates and 42% marks for OBC and 40% marks for S.C./ S.T. to be able to pursue professional degree in law (LL.B) at Kokrajhar Law College under Bodoland University.

### **Age on Admission:**

The age factor for the admission to the LL.B. 3 Years degree course will be as per the guidelines of the Bar Council of India/Bodoland University regarding the Maximum age eligibility. At present those seeking admission should not attain the maximum age of 30 years for the General as on 1<sup>st</sup> June of admission year. The Maximum of 35 years for S.C./S.T. or any other backward community/category with the relaxation as fixed by the Bar Council of India, UGC and Bodoland University Regulations.

### The online admission procedure of session 2025 - 2026 will be three stages:

**First** the students are to submit the online application form filling all the required information by payment of application fee Rs.350.00 (Rupees Three Hundred Fifty Only). The user account will be generated for the applied students and it must be kept by student for future reference. Application link is given in the college website <a href="https://bunivadm.samarth.edu.in">www.klc.ac.in</a> or directly visit at <a href="https://bunivadm.samarth.edu.in">https://bunivadm.samarth.edu.in</a>

**Second** the applied students those who are selected for online admission by the college will get admitted by payment of the entire required fees at one time through the quick payment link available in the college website <a href="www.klc.ac.in">www.klc.ac.in</a>. The selection list will be displayed in the website and also in the notice board of the college.

Third after successful payment the candidates have to submit the application form along with necessary enclosures and successful payment receipt at the office of KLC. On receipt of these particulars the college shall issue fee payment receipt/admission receipt which shall be conclusive proof that he/she is now a registered enrolled student of KLC.

## Documents required to be submitted along with the online admission application form and successful payment receipt:

- 1. HSLC or Equivalent Examination Admit Card (for age proof) and Marksheet
- 2. HS or Equivalent Examination Marksheet
- 3. Degree or Graduation Mark-Sheet & Pass Certificate (mandatory)
- 4. Transfer Certificate from institution last attended.
- 5. Caste/ Tribe Certificate from Competent Authority (If Applicable)
- 6. Migration Certificate (compulsory if the highest attained degree is from other University)
- 7. Registration Certificate
- 8. Three recent passport size photograph
- 9. Gap Certificate (Those graduated in 2023 and earlier)

### 10. All the educational qualification marksheet, pass certificate.

#### **Selection Procedure:**

The applicants will be admitted on the basis of the merit accordingly the selection list will be notified; however, taking into account the number of applicants if exceed the intake capacity then the Admission Test or Interview may be conducted. The date for such Admission test or Interview, if conducted will be notified in the Notice Board of the College and website <a href="https://www.klc.ac.in">www.klc.ac.in</a> from time to time.

## Intake Capacity: 120 Important Regulations:

- No student is allowed to pursue any other full time course of the study during his or her tenure of being student of LL.B. course.
- ➤ In case a student fails to attend classes for one month at a stretch from the date of Admission his/her name shall be struck off from the rolls of register.
- The intake capacity in a class is 120 (1st Year), with 60 students in each section. The medium of instruction and examination is English.
- Every paper as detailed in the syllabus of LL.B. course study shall be of 100 marks with theory carrying 70 marks and internal assessment of 30 marks.
- The students have to score 13/30 in each subject in the internal assessment conducted by the college time to time and 32/80 in the end semester theory examination conducted by the Bodoland University to be able to pass that particular semester.
- ➤ The duration of end semester examination for every paper will be of three hours.

### ADMISSION of LL.B 2nd and 3rd Year

Students who are going to be promoted to LL.B 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year shall continue to take admission through college portal i.e; www.klc.ac.in with the same user id and password created earlier.

The payment of entire fees is mandatory. Payments can be made using debit cards/internet banking through the given portal for online admission.

\*No installment payments shall be allowed. No REFUND of admission fee.

<u>NB</u>: First Two female S.T. students belonging to BPL family if found eligible for admission in 1<sup>st</sup> Year on merit basis will be admitted with 50% concession on total fees.

The admitted students must follow the BCI rules & regulations along with Bodoland University rules while pursuing the 3 years L.L.B. course to appear the End Semester Examination:

No student shall be allowed to take the end semester examination in a subject if the student concerned has not attended minimum of 70% of the classes held in the subject concerned as also the moot court room exercises, tutorials and practical training conducted in the subject taken together. Provided that if a student for any exceptional reasons fail to attend 70% of the classes held in any subject, the Dean of the University or the Principal of the Centre of Legal Education, as the case may be, may allow the student to take the examination if the student concerned attended at least 65% of the classes held in the subject concerned and attended 70% of classes in all the subjects taken together. The similar power shall rest with the Vice Chancellor or Director of a National Law University, or his authorized representative in the absence of the Dean of Law. Provided, further that a list of such students allowed taking the test with reasons recorded be forwarded to the Bar Council of India.

The Bodoland University guidelines in regard to the conduct of Session Test, Seminars and assignments time to time within the semester period are mandatory for all the students of the college. Failing to attend the same will face consequences accordingly

because it is the part of the academic practice which involves continuous comprehensive evaluation system.

The ragging is completely banned in the College and being the legal education institute all forms of harassment, unlawful activities are banned within the campus. Ragging is a crime and it ruins the innocent lives and careers at any stage of attaining higher education. There will be strong monitoring and students are expected to cooperate with the college authority in such cases and to spread the awareness against ragging across the campus and society.

### **College Uniform Regulation:**

The students have to come with prescribed college uniform in all the class days except on Tuesday (Own Traditional dress). This is mandatory for all semesters.
